Students who accept an invitation to the Early Admission Program (EA), are required to <u>complete the</u> <u>HOPE</u> graduation requirement by the end of June (by June 15 for courses taken through FLVS (Florida <u>Virtual School</u>) prior to the first day of EA classes commencing @ St Petersburg College (SPC), Fall Term of their 12th grade High School year. Failure to successfully complete this requirement timely will disqualify student from EA and will result in Pinellas County Schools (PCS) rescinding the invitation to participate in EA.

Acceptable variations to completing HOPE:

Students who do not qualify for a HOPE waiver; have not successfully completed HOPE; or are not in the process of completing the HOPE requirement via their High School during 2nd Semester of their Junior year; are expected to enroll in HOPE via Pinellas Virtual School (PVS) immediately upon acceptance of an invitation to EA to ensure ample time to complete HOPE by last day of grade 11 or no later than June 30th, prior to start of Senior year. See directions for registering via PVS below. Students on the waiting list for an opportunity to participate in EA are also encouraged to enroll in HOPE to ensure they meet eligibility should a seat in EA become available.
