


Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing (BS-NUR)

Admission Requirements Checklist

- Beginning Fall 2024, the RN to BSN program begins every Fall: August & October, Spring: January & March, and Summer: June Term.
- **No Deadlines:** The program will accept applications continually throughout the year for the next available start date.
- Please apply once you complete all admission criteria and allow up to four weeks for processing.

1.		SPC Application: Complete the St. Petersburg College Admission Application . New students complete the application and pay the non-refundable fee. Returning students complete the application but are not subject to the fee.
2.		Official high school transcript: Submit official, unopened (sealed) high school transcript or GED transcripts indicating completion of standard high school diploma or equivalency. <i>Foreign language requirement can be met (after admission to college) but prior to the completion of the bachelor's degree if not completed in HS program.</i>
3.		Other Colleges transcripts: Submit official transcripts from all regionally accredited college(s) and universities currently or previously attended. <i>Note: Transcripts from schools outside the U.S. must be evaluated by a NACES approved agency</i>
4.		Earned AS/AAS or Nursing Diploma: Submit official transcript showing completion of an AS (or AAS) Degree in Nursing from a regionally accredited institution listed at https://ope.ed.gov/accreditation/Search.aspx or a Diploma in Nursing from a program accredited by the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing/ACEN (formerly, National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission NLNAC) program listed at www.acenursing.org
5.		Admission GPA requirement: Students must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.00 on a 4.00 scale in all postsecondary coursework.
6.		College level reading, writing and math: Students must demonstrate they are at college level in Reading, Writing and Math either through appropriate test scores, or through appropriate course completion. Official transcripts will be evaluated by SPC.
7.		RN License: Submit your active, unrestricted, unencumbered (i.e. clear/active) RN license information. <i>Note: This is to be kept current and unrestricted throughout the duration of the program.</i> <i>* The RN to BSN Admission Application will provide the opportunity to input your required RN license information as you complete the application.</i>
8.		College of Nursing Application: Submit the Baccalaureate Health Admission Application for the RN to BSN Program at https://webapps.spcollege.edu/hec/app_ud/
