Saint Petersburg College has changed the name of the Certificate program in Digital Media Multimedia Presentation to the Certificate program in Digital Media/Multimedia/UX. This change was made in order to help students better recognize the program's intent and purpose. The curriculum and all other aspects of the program remain the same.

The College is also adding two new programs: the Advanced Technical Certificate program in Emergency Management Administration and the Associate of Science (A.S.) degree program in Production Systems. The Certificate is a repackaging of existing curriculum from other related health science programs, and is intended for students who already have an A.S. degree in the area of public safety or emergency management. The A.S. degree in Production Systems replaces the former A.S. degree program in Industrial Management Technology, which was closed in October 2017, and is a repackaging of the existing curriculum.

Since these changes will require no additional faculty, facilities, or other resources for implementation the College has determined that they do not constitute a significant departure from existing offerings. Therefore, they are not considered to be a substantive change requiring notification or approval.

For future reference, new programs that are not significant departures from existing programs are not substantive changes and should not be submitted to the Commission.
