Enrollment and Program Updates

BASDH Update: Siladie

- We had an uptick in enrollment for our August 2015 cohorts of new students— last August (2014) we had 27 new students, this August (2015) we accepted and enrolled 32 new students. 45 graduated in 2014. Approximately 100-120 students in the cohorts.
- Our BASDH program will have a booth/table at Florida Dental Hygiene Symposium in Orlando in October. As this is highly attended by ASDH students, it is a great recruiting event for us.
- The COHS continues to participate in the new blogging effort at St. Petersburg College. Our goal is to have each program in the COHS blog at least once a semester under the Health Sciences section of the blog. - Resigning Full Time Faculty/Faculty updates
 - Linda Johnson and Sandi Marcil resigning May 2016
 - Katie Woods accepting Academic Chair position
- Curriculum update – New DEH 2802 Practice Management course going to Curriculum Committee and State DOE this fall for implementation in summer of 2016. Adding additional credit to Community course in fall semester because heavily tested on National Board Exam. Will no longer have DEH 2930 Dental Hygiene Topics course.
- HESI (Health Education Systems Inc) preparation, assessment and curriculum management program
 - National Board preparation
 - Reporting for curriculum management
 - \$78 per student sponsored this year by SPC
- Freshmen class total 36 with three students readmitting
- Sophomores class total 30
- National Board exam – 100 % pass rate first attempt
- Clinical Exam – 84 % pass rate first attempt/ four passed on second attempt/one still attempting in November Miami Dade
- Class of 2015 donated a brand new refrigerator for future students to use- value \$600

Pinellas County School Sealing Smiles in Pinellas:

- March & April 2015 - sophomore class at Skyview Elementary
 - 48 patients treated/ 48 screenings done
 - 158 Sealants Placed
 - Total \$10,140.00
- Committee informed SPC of new ADA Dental Sealant Code for repair
- Received SPC Innovation Grant for \$3500 to continue Sealant Program equipment and purchased another chair, compressor and gift certificates for class /teacher.
- Class of 2015 donated money for another isolation system Isolyte for sealant program- value \$1600.00
- Pinellas Park Rotary Club donated \$755.99 towards a sealant light for the Sealing Smiles and then an additional \$700 which will be used toward supplies.
- Other local activities continue as usual each year
- Lesson's in a Lunch Box distribution is being organized for February through the Children's Oral Health Institute

- % Digital charting / paperless records in the community dental practices- 80-90% referrals are using digital xrays. Patients are expecting digital. Paperless still not vast majority.
- Dental dam's – type being used is the traditional dam with clamp.
- A1C Diabetes number not being specifically asked but all agree it's a specific question that will prompt more dialogue.
