Reflection form for Service Learning

In about 300 words, reflect on what you have learned from your volunteer experience. You might want to take two or three of the following questions to help you get started.

- 1. Relate some principle from your class work to your experience. How have some of the ideas from your class helped you to understand your experience? How have they helped you to be more effective? Have you observed examples of these ideas being used by others in the organization?
- 2. Give two examples of something you have learned about working with people of different races, cultures or backgrounds. How has this affected you personally?
- 3. Give two examples, either positive or negative, of effectiveness working with others. What did you observe? What did you learn from your own interactions?
- 4. Describe three things you have learned about yourself. They might be attitudes, strengths, weaknesses, passions or values.
- 5. Three years from now, you will have forgotten much about this experience. Write at least three paragraphs of things you may forget but want to remember. You may want to include feelings, desires, insights about yourself or about life, commitments or goals.

Be sure to include your name, the course number and the name of your instructor and turn your essay in to your instructor for credit.
