

Transfer & Advanced Placement Students

The individuality of Radiography Programs across the country creates a challenge for accepting transfer students into the program. Each student requesting a transfer must have their current Radiography Program evaluated for compatibility with the St. Petersburg College (SPC) Radiography Program curriculum. SPC also requires that at least 25% of the course credit hours required for the degree must be completed at SPC. For the Radiography Program, this would require a minimum of 19 credit hours.

Advanced placement students are considered for admissions on a clinic space availability basis. If more than one student applies for advanced placement and there is room for only one additional student in the cohort, the date of the completed application will be the determining factor for entrance into the program.

The following are the policies and procedures related to advanced placement into the SPC Radiography Program.

The applicant must:

1. Complete the SPC online application.
2. Contact an advisor from Student Affairs at the Health Education Center regarding the application process for the Radiography Program.
3. Complete the steps required for the Experiential Learning Program if required.
4. Be either currently enrolled in a Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology (JRCERT) accredited Radiography Program or has recently left a program in good standing within the past six months. A letter from the former radiography program director will be required for verification.
