Tuition Due Dates

Universal Due Date for Winter Session, Full Term, Weekend College and First 8 Week Session for enrollment between Oct. 23 and Dec. 11 Dec. 11

If your tuition is not received or if you have not been awarded financial aid by this date, the classes you have registered for will be removed from your schedule. You can re-register for classes on a space-available basis.

Financial Aid Awarded Date for FAS Due Date Extension for enrollment between Oct. 23 and Dec. 11 Dec. 11

You can still apply for financial aid after this date; however, you will need to make arrangements for tuition payments while your file is processed.

Second Due Date for Full Term, Weekend College and First 8 Week Session or enrollment between Dec. 12 and Jan. 3 Jan. 3

If your tuition is not received or if you have not been awarded financial aid by this date, the classes you have registered for will be removed from your schedule. You can re-register for classes on a space-available basis.

FAS Due Date Extension March 20

This extension is for students who are awarded a financial aid package by Dec. 11 or Jan. 3. If your financial aid award does not cover the entire balance, you must pay your balance by this date.

Students with an extended due date will not be dropped for non-payment by this date. The student may continue in the class, but will be billed for the amount owed. Future registration will not be available until the balance is paid in full.

50% down payment with 2 monthly payments and \$45 enrollment fee Jan. 10 (Jan. & Feb.)

Email	All email notifications are sent to your SPC student email <i>Students may forward their SPC student email to a personal email.</i>
Awarding Verification	Financial aid awarding occurs DAILY, email notifications are sent DAILY 14 working days from the receipt date of all required documentation <i>Once complete, the verification item(s) will be removed from your MySPC To Do List.</i>
SAP Appeals	15 working days from the receipt date of all required documentation, email notifications are sent DAILY <i>Once a decision is made, the SAP item will be removed from your MySPC To Do List. To check the current SAP status, login to MySPC, select "Financial Aid Status," select the aid year and look in the box in the top right-hand corner.</i>

Students will be notified by email if, during peak processing times, the benchmarks above have been revised.

TOTAL WITHDRAWAL

Know the consequences of this decision. If you completely withdraw from the college, you will be required to repay financial aid funds. You must phone the SPC Call Center at 727-341-4772 as you are not able to totally withdraw from all classes through MySPC. Withdrawing from a class or all classes will negatively affect your Satisfactory Academic Progress calculations and could affect your ability to receive financial aid in the future.

Last Date to Withdraw from All Classes and Incur Repayment of Federal Financial Aid Funds

If you withdraw from all of your classes BEFORE or ON this date, you will be required to repay all or part of your federal financial aid disbursed in that term.
